Angela Minor, LPN

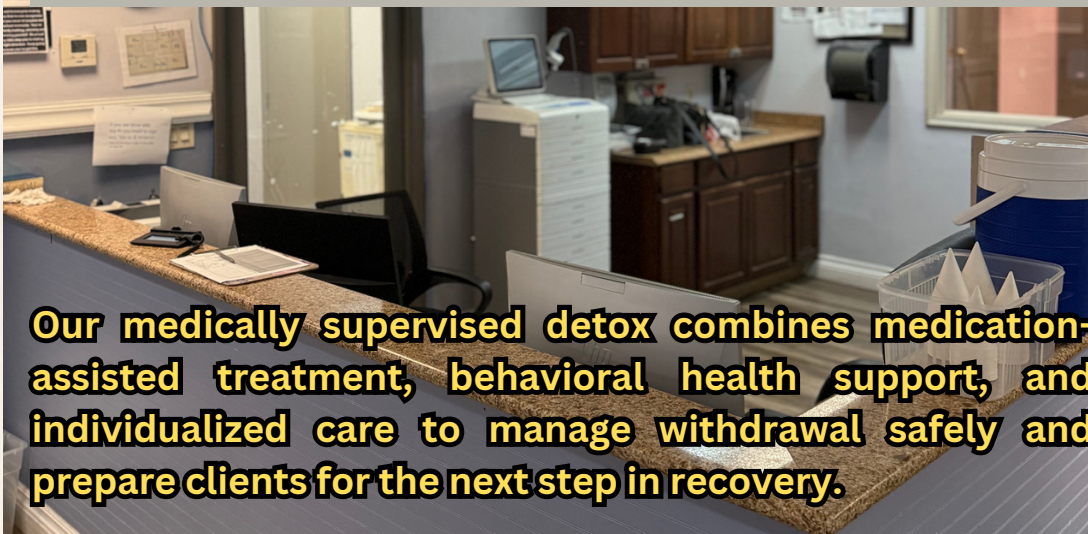
